

High speed portable boat lifts

Ever since early man stored the first boat in the water, sailors have had to endure the consequences, including dirty boat bottoms and boat sinking. Options for storing boats dry over the water have not been very practical for Europe, since they have required pilings and other permanent structures.

Now, the ten-year-old US company Sunstream Boat Lifts is importing high-speed portable boat lifts that eliminate these problems. The FloatLift is a floating lift that ties to a dock or mooring like a boat and can be used almost anywhere. The SunLift is a free-standing lift that is supported by the sea bed. All Sunstream lifts are charged by either Solar or AC power and have a battery back-up. Remote control allows the user to raise or lower the high-speed lift in only 30 seconds from the driver's seat.

For those of us who do not like struggling with boat covers, the FloatLift and SunLift offer optional tops which keep the top of the boat as clean as the bottom. Sunstream CEO, Ken Hey, comments: "Sunstream's high-tech products quickly became popular throughout the US because boaters now use their boat more often with less hassle. I think the European market is taking off even faster since they not only appreciate this aspect, but Europeans put a higher premium on a clean boat".

Marina owners can add to their revenues by adding multi-tiered pricing with premium berths by offering consumers a mooring with either a boat lift or one with a boat lift and canopy.
